Overview:

iStart Rajasthan is a flagship initiative by the Government of Rajasthan intended to foster innovation, create jobs and facilitate investment. The program aims to nurture innovation and entrepreneurship which would further help in the economic growth and development of the state. Through this initiative, the State Government intends to build an environment where there would be an easy access to knowledge exchange and funding.

Since the iStart Nest centre opened in Jaipur in December, the next expansion is targeted in the cities of Kota and Udaipur for the incubation of startups. In the month of February, the team is now on ground and working to finalise the space and other formalities for developing world class incubation centres in the respective cities. With the consistent revamping of the iStart portal to provide as much information and support to startups and the formation of such incubation centres, it is likely the state would soon emerge as a preferred destination for incorporation and operations of young businesses as well

Expansion Strategy: As per the announcements made to expand the footprint of iStart Nest in other cities in December 2017, the teams has been reached to Kota and Udaipur to do the ground work for the formation of world-class incubation centres. Currently, the incubation centres have been started in the Abhay Command Centre at both the locations respectively. Once the incubations centres are launched, they would provide all the physical infrastructure and support systems necessary for business incubation activities and promote and facilitate knowledge creation, innovation and entrepreneurship activities in the respective cities.

A) Open Source Incubator – Paytm: Build for India
